SBCCD BOARD ACCEPTS VISION FOR SUCCESS FIRST READ

In the 2017 Vision for Success, the California Community College Chancellor's Office and Board of Governors established ambitious systemwide goals for improved student outcomes. SBCCD has the opportunity to articulate how it will contribute to reaching the systemwide goals for improvement.

These goals will guide SBCCD for the next five years and confirm to SBCCD's college community and the community it serves that earnest efforts are underway to improve performance.

Systemwide Goal 1 (Completion): Increase by at least 20 percent the number of students annually who acquire associate degrees, credentials, certificates, or specific job-oriented skill sets.

Local Target (CHC and SBVC): Increase the number of associate degrees awarded by 20%.

SBCCD's 5-year goals has a baseline year of 2016-17 and an ending year of 2021-22 using Student Success Metrics data.

Equity data is still being validated by the state and will be included when Vision for Success Local Goal Setting is provided

to the SBCCD Board of Trustees for a second read in May 2019.
