



Top 20 Feeder High Schools of Enrolled SBCCD Students by College from Fall 2010 to Fall 2014

Purpose of Brief

The purpose of this report is to identify the top 20 feeder high schools for both Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College.

Summary of Findings

- The percent of first-time college students at Valley has remained relatively the same at 12%, peaking in Fall 2013 at 14%.
- The percent of first-time college students at Crafton increased from 13% in Fall 2010 to 17% in Fall 2014.

Overview

The purpose of this report is to identify the top 20 feeder high schools for both Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College. The information from this report will be used to inform the District Enrollment Management Plan and the development of plans district wide.

Methodology

In order to identify the top 20 feeder high schools for both colleges' three files were generated and merged together. First, students who earned a grade on record (GOR) in Fall 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2014 were identified for both Crafton and Valley by accessing this information from Ellucian. Fall 2015 was not examined because the first-time college student data was not available at the time of the report. GOR is defined as earning a grade of A, B, C, D, F, I, NP, P, or W and demonstrates that a student was enrolled past the census date of the section.

Next, the following Informer Report was used to identify the high schools that students attended: [Prior Institutions Attended](#). One of the limitations of the high school data is that students may have attended multiple high schools. Rather than counting students twice, which may be misleading, the data was unduplicated with priority being given to students who graduated with a high school diploma or equivalent in the most recent year. As an illustration, if a student attended Colton and Rialto and graduated from Colton, Colton was identified as the feeder high school.

The third file was accessed from the California Community College Chancellor's Management Information System (CCCCOMIS). One of the files provided by CCCCCOMIS is the First File. The First File contains a field that identifies the term a student first attended college in the United States. In order to identify this information, the CCCCCO submits a file to the National Student Clearinghouse where they do a one-to-one match on SSN to over 95% of all of the higher education institutions in the United States. The first term enrolled in college was merged into the GOR file and if the terms matched, these students were identified as first time college students. A limitation of using the CCCCCOMIS data is that not all students report an SSN and when merging data from CCCCCOMIS to Ellucian there are some missing records.

Sample

Table 1 illustrates the number and percent of first-time college students for both Crafton and Valley. The percent of first-time college students at Valley has remained relatively the same at 12%, peaking in Fall 2013 at 14%. On the other hand, the percent of first-time college students at Crafton increased from 13% in Fall 2010 to 17% in Fall 2014.

Findings

Tables 2 and 3 on the following page illustrate the top 20 feeder high schools for San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) and Crafton Hills College (CHC). The top 10 feeder high schools in Fall 2014 for SBVC and CHC are listed below.

San Bernardino Valley College

When examining the top feeder high schools for SBVC further, San Gorgonio High was the top feeder high school until Fall 2013 when Colton High went from number 2 to number 1. In addition, Pacific High moved from a rank of number 8 in Fall 2010 to number 2 in Fall 2014. Similarly, home schooling also moved from a rank of 9 in Fall 2010 to rank of 3 in Fall 2014.

When examining the top feeder high schools for Crafton, Redlands East Valley High was the top feeder high school until Fall 2012, when Yucaipa High became the top feeder high school. Citrus High is a relatively new high school and has consistently increased from a rank of 6 in Fall 2012 to a rank of 3 in Fall 2014. The number of first-time college students from Citrus High has increased from 33 in Fall 2012 to 119 in Fall 2014, an increase of 86 (261%).
