





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 97.4% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 99.8% in 2015-16 to 96.0% in 2019-20, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 0.2% in 2015-16 to 4.0% in 2019-20.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District increased by 15.7% from 4,876 in 2015-16 to 5,635 in 2019-20. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+789 sections, a 17.4% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-232 sections, a 67.4% decrease).

Although it presents a small percentage of total section offerings, non-credit section offerings dramatically increased (+220 sections, a 2750.0% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 99.1% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit slightly declined from 99.6% in 2015-16 to 99.2% in 2019-20, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly increased from 0.4% in 2015-16 to 0.8% in 2019-20.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College increased by 6.7%, from 1,679 in 2015-16 to 1,792 in 2019-20. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+130 sections, a 8.3% increase) and for non-credit (+8 sections, a 133.3% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-25 sections, a 23.1% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 96.5% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit declined from 99.9% in 2015-16 to 94.5% in 2019-20, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased from 0.1% in 2015-16 to 5.5% in 2019-20.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college increased by 22.3% from 3,197 in 2015-16 to 3,618 in 2019-20. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+659 sections, a 22.3% increase) and for non-credit (+212 sections, a 10600.0% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-207 sections, a 87.7% decrease).

### Number of Sections by Transfer Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 76.4% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 2.2%, from 76.7% in 2015-16 to 78.9% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+1,153 sections, a 80.1% increase), and not transferable (+57 sections, a 5.0% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in transferable only to CSU (-833 sections, a 46.2% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Transfer Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 81.5% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 2.9%, from 80.7% in 2015-16 to 84.7% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+351 sections, a 41.5% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-189 sections, a 35.0% decrease) and not transferable (-49 sections, a 1.2% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 73.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 1.6%, from 74.6% in 2015-16 to 76.2% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+1202 sections, a 110.0% increase and not transferable (+256 sections, a 32.1% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-644 sections, a 49.8% decrease).

# Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 21.4% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 3.0%, from 19.7% in 2015-16 to 22.7% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+ 320 sections, a 33.3% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+457 sections, a 11.7% increase).



On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 13.8% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 3.4%, from 12.4% in 2015-16 to 15.8% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+75 sections, a 36.1% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+38 sections, a 2.6% increase).



On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 25.1% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 2.3%, from 23.6% in 2015-16 to 25.9% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+245 sections, a 32.5% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+419 sections, a 17.2% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 6.3% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 3.5% from 6.5% in 2015-16 to 3.0% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among for Non-Basic Skills (+922 sections, a 20.2% increase), while a decrese in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-145 sections, a 46.0% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 5.9% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 3.0%, from 5.8% in 2015-16 to 2.8% in 2019-20.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills Courses (-48 sections, a 49.0% decrease), while an increase in the number of Non-Basic skills sections increased by 10.2% (+161 sections, a 10.2% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 6.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses increased by 3.7%, from 6.8% in 2015-16 to 3.1% in 2019-20.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills Courses (-97 sections, a 44.7% decrease), while an increase in the number of Non-Basic skills sections increased by 10.2% (+761 sections, a 25.5% increase).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) declined by 12.9%, from 62.7% in 2015-16 to 49.8% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of Positive Attendance section offerings (+5.6%), Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+5.5%), and Daily Census section offerings (+1.8%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Daily Census section offerings (+236 sections, a 28.3% increase), positive attendance section offerings (+354 sections, a 145.1% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+427 sections, a 57.5% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-240 sections, a 7.9% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) significantly declined by 18.9%, from 65.2% in 2015-16 to 46.3% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of Daily Census section offerings (+8.7%), Independent Study, Work Experience section offerings (+7.2%), and Positive Attendance section offerings (+3.1%) increased.

Over this period, there was a larger increase in Daily Census section offerings (+175 sections, a 56.8% increase), Positive Attendance section offerings (+61 sections, a 67.0% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+142 sections, a 76.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-265 sections, a 13.1% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) declined by 9.9%, from 61.3% in 2015-16 to 51.4% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of Positive Attendance offerings (6.8%), Independent study and work experience section offerings (+4.4%), and Daily census section offerings (+2.3%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Weekly Census section offerings (+80 sections, a 1.3% increase), Daily Census section offerings (+61 sections, a 11.6% increase), Positive Attendance section offerings (+293 sections, a 191.5% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+285 sections, a 51.3% increase).



Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of sections offered at the SBVC and CHC Campuses slightly declined by 2.4%. Over this same period, the percentage of sections offered at the SBVC Off-campus (+2.2%), SB Sheriff Dept. Training Center (+0.6%), and CHC Off-campus (+0.6%) increased.

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 5.4%, from 83.9% in 2015-16 to 78.5% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 6.4%, from 11.1% in 2015-16 to 17.5% in 2019-20.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (+345 sections, a 8.4% increase) and fully online section offerings (+447 sections, a 82.8% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among hybrid section offerings (-5 sections, a 2.1% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 8.2%, from 89.5% in 2015-16 to 81.3% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 7.8%, from 6.8% in 2015-16 to 16.5% in 2019-20.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+149 sections, a 102.1% increase), and hybrid section offerings (+10 sections, a 33.3% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (-46 sections, a 3.1% decrease),

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 3.8% from 80.9% in 2015-16 to 77.1% in 2019-20. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 5.6%, from 12.3% in 2015-16 to 17.9% in 2019-20.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (+391 sections, a 15.1% increase), fully online section offerings (+298 sections, a 75.6% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among hybrid section offerings (-15 sections, a 7.3% decrease).


On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 60.4% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 6.3%, from 14.9% in 2015-16 to 21.2% in 2019-20.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+388 sections, a 12.8% increase), and Unknown section offerings (+487 sections, a 65.4% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-85 sections, a 7.5% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Meeting Time: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 63.2% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 8.0%, from 13.5% in 2015-16 to 21.5% in 2019-20.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+18 sections, a 1.6% increase and Unknown section offerings (+159 sections, a 70.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-64 sections, a 18.0% decrease).

On average, between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 59.4% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 5.5%, from 15.6% in 2015-16 to 21.1% in 2019-20.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+370 section, a 19.2% increase) and Unknown section offerings (+315 sections, a 63.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-21 sections, a 2.7% decrease).
