Have you seen these chairs? They are located in buildings throughout campus at Valley and Crafton. Ever wonder what they are for?

The ADA requires each building to have accessible means of egress (ADAAG 4.1.3(9), 4.3.10), but does not specify a solution. During most emergencies, the preferred method of egress — elevators — are out of service for safety reasons.
